Proper lubrication for IBA Manowar Finish

The IBA Manowar finish seals the metal. Due to the lack of penetration or traveling of lubricant, grease should not be used except on the lugs and cam surface of the bolt. The best form of lubrication for the actual bolt body is Montana Extreme oil or FP10 oil. The lighter the oil is the better it works. Using a heavy oil or grease will only gum up the bolt body causing difficult cycling of the bolt.

Proper cleaning of IBA Manowar finished parts

The best way to clean any part coated with the IBA Manowar finish is with normal Hoppe's yellow label bore cleaner. Wipe the part down with a wet patch and leave it wet, if preferred. Using Sontara Aircraft wipes works the best.
